Special Funding Opportunities

- 1. **Community Garden Grants**: This project-based funding is for those organizations looking to establish community gardens on previously underutilized green spaces or to improve upon and/or expand existing gardens. This could be patches of land connected with schools, houses of worship, community centers, etc. Organizations can apply for up to \$5,000 per garden. An organization is eligible to apply for support of multiple gardens in one application.
- 2. **Inspirational Grants**: We are offering grants of up to \$10,000 to fund inspiring proposals to bring equity, justice and healing to communities that have been systematically neglected by unjust policies, laws, and practices. The proposals should be collaborative in nature and designed to foster healthy, vibrant and thriving communities. Projects have a greater chance of success if they showcase multiple community partners working together to accomplish a common goal. We recognize that there are organizations throughout Chicago that are doing some amazing work.
